Technique Classes

Liberty: This pillow is made with a great painting technique! No painting experience necessary and all painting supplies are included! Stop and see the sample.
Class Fee: \$15.00 plus kit Tues. Feb. 3 (10:30-3:30)

Beginning Hand Piecing: We will be using "Quiltmaking By Hand" by Jinny Beyer This is a breathtakingly beautiful book showcasing techniques for making quilts by hand while capturing the romance of quiltmaking in simpler times past.
Class Fee: \$25.00 plus supplies Friday Feb. 6, 13, 20, 27 and March13 (1-4)

Aged Painting Techniques: Join Linda as she shares her tips and tricks to give anything a great aged look. You will paint either a comb box or frame Class Fee:15.00 plus supplies (all paints are included) March 7 (10:30-2:30)

IMA Invisible Machine Appliqué: Teena will guide you through this easy method of (IMA) You will be working on a wonderful Pineapple Quilt from Linda Brannock. After this class you will be able to do all those appliquéd quilts you have been wanting to do. You must have a good working knowledge of your machine.

Mini Hit and Miss Table Mat (Rug Hooking): Join Pam as she instructs you on the techniques needed to complete this scrappy table mat using strips of wool and a metal hook!

Hand Appliqué: Using the pattern Spring Fling by Jan Patek we will be teaching three methods of appliqué, needle turn, prepared and the starch method, you can then choose which technique suits you best and go on to finish the project. Class Fee: \$20.00 Plus Supplies Sat. Feb. 21 OR Fri. April 3 (10:30-2:30)



Hand Quilting: Now you have some piecing done, the pattern says quilt as desired ?? Now what? This is the class for you. Basting, marking, needles, thread , and of course the “waddle” of quilting will be shown in this class. Class Fee \$25.00 includes supplies Tues. March 3 (1-4) **OR** Sat. April 4 (1-4)

Beginning Quiltmaking by Machine: This class will focus on accurate piecing, cutting and pressing. We will be making an Irish Chain Quilt. Class Fee: \$20.00 plus Supplies Sat. March 7 (10:30-2:30)

Needle Roll: *This is a “Good Wives” version of a handy needle roll to hold all of your “needful” stuff (pins, needles, thread etc)* Class Fee: \$15.00 plus supplies Sat. March 14 (10:30-2:30)

Wool Appliqué: Spring has sprung! Wool bunnies will help you usher in the spring season. You will learn several techniques to accent your table runner! Stop by and see the sample! Class Fee: \$15.00 plus supplies Fri. March 20 (12-4)
